Please bring the following items:

- Photo ID for you and your spouse if filing jointly.
- Note: Everyone must bring a Social Security card or ITIN letter for all family members, including returning customers.
- All income statements: W-2, W-P, W-2G & 1099, etc.
- All income statements for each working dependent: W-2, etc.
- Voided check for direct deposit.
- Expense documents: dependent care, education-related expenses, home mortgage interest payments.
- Forms 1095-A from the Marketplace for those claiming the Premium Tax Credit.
